March 1 Billing - We have sent out invoices for the March 1 billing over the past few days. If you have not received yours or can't find it, please let Mr. Fox know. The tenth and final tuition installment will be due on May 1, and the last day for the early re-enrollment discount will be June 1. You will receive an invoice toward the end of May that you can use to easily pay the \$400 early re-enrollment fee online.

Re-Enrollment Process

1. At your earliest convenience, download the re-enrollment packet from lvaes.org/returning. When finished, you can upload electronically using the link at lvaes.org/returning or print and submit to the office.
2. Your child will complete the re-enrollment essay in class, so you do not need to worry about this.
3. On or before June 1, pay the re-enrollment fee. We will send out an electronic invoice around May 20 for payment by June 1. (The full re-enrollment fee is \$450, but you will receive a \$50 discount if you pay by June 1.)

End of Quarter 3 is in two weeks! We will be holding parent teacher conferences from 8:00-12:00 on Friday, March 18. (These conferences are optional unless your child's teacher requests a conference.) We prefer to meet in person, but we can also meet over Zoom if necessary. Next week, we will be sending out a sign up link for parents who would like to discuss their child's progress.

Distance-Learning Day - For students, Friday, March 18 will be a distance-learning day, and students will need to complete assignments at home. School attendance for that day will be based on completion of the assignments.

Work Bee - We'll be holding a work bee on Sunday, March 13 from 9:00-12:00. We need help with general items like landscape maintenance (weed whacking, weeding garden beds, trimming bushes, etc.).
