Ventura Church Visit is TOMORROW, Saturday, February 4! If your child signed up for the third church performance, then performance is required. Filtered Water - We have installed five-stage, reverse osmosis water filters in each of our classrooms. **Remember to send your child with a refillable water bottle each day!**
