Procedure Reminders -

Classroom Appointments - At Linda Vista, we believe that education is a partnership between parents and teachers, and it is our goal to ensure that parents feel invited in to their child's school experience. It is also important that there is a framework that helps students understand the difference between the home space and school space, that reduces distractions to the classroom dynamics and activities, and that allows teachers to teach without feeling scrutinized. For this reason, we require that parents arrange — through the principal and in advance —all in-class visits. We also ask that conversations with teachers are arranged for after school or during a prescheduled appointment.

Signing In - Linda Vista is a closed campus, and all visitors, volunteers, and parents need to sign in at the office when on-campus during school hours. Please don't head to your child's classroom without permission from the office, including for birthday celebrations.

After-School Supervision - Ensuring that your children are safe (Body, Heart, Mind, and Soul) is one of our top priorities. The before and after school time presents more challenges for our supervision since it is less clear where students need to be and to whom they should be listening. For this reason, we require all students to be in Daycare unless they are in the physical presence of their parent. We ask parents who check their child out of Daycare but remain on campus to ensure that their children stay close to them and continue to follow the school guidelines. This helps to avoid any confusion about who is in charge of a child's supervision.

Restroom Use - We now have a single-use bathroom available for our staff and visitors, and we're reserving the student restrooms for student use. If you need to use the restroom while on campus, please inquire in the office for a key.
