

LVAES 1:1 iPad Program

To ensure that our teachers and students are prepared for the uncertainties of this school year and to provide them with tools for the best education possible, LVAES is implementing a 1:1 iPad program. We are highly encouraging each student to have an Apple iPad and keyboard case that he/she can take to and from school. Families may use one that they already have, purchase one on their own, or lease-to-own an iPad/keyboard case from LVAES for \$150/year plus optional insurance. At the end of three years, families may purchase the device for \$10. Families that provide their own tablet will be charged \$19/year for [Securly](#) filtering and device management.

We believe that technology is a tool for learning, not the solution. As such, iPads will be used where they will benefit student learning the most; they should not become the center of the classroom or home. There are many opportunities to enrich and individualize learning with iPads, and that is how we plan to use them. In these times of uncertainty and distance learning, iPads will be especially useful.

Frequently Asked Questions (Updated 8/7/20)

What devices will the school provide with the lease-to-own program? When you sign up for the iPad 1:1 program, you will receive the newest model of the standard iPad (currently the 7th generation 10.2" iPad with 32GB and A10 Fusion chip) and a protective case that includes a full keyboard. A stylus is recommended but is not provided with the lease-to-own program.

Can I provide my own iPad and keyboard case? Yes. It is recommended that the iPad be any model of iPad that has been released in the past three years.

My child already has a non-Apple tablet. Do I need to purchase an iPad too? If your child will be bringing a tablet to school, it must be an Apple iPad with Securly installed and managed by LVAES.

My child has a smart phone. Can he/she use that? No.

How will devices be managed? All devices used for the 1:1 program must be managed with [Securly](#). This is a safety and management system that allows the school to deploy apps to iPads, filter content, monitor for at-risk activity, and guide usage. Securly also allows parents to do much of the same at home, such as setting access times, restricting app and website usage, receiving notification of certain behaviors, etc. The cost of Securly is covered by the \$150 yearly lease-to-own fee. *Students who provide their own Apple iPad will be charged a **yearly fee of \$19.***

I am providing a tablet for my child to use with the 1:1 program. Does Securly have to be installed on it? Yes, Securly must be installed and managed by LVAES for a device to be used with the 1:1 program, even if it is a device provided by you. Teachers must have the ability to monitor and guide activity in the classroom and related to LVAES.

Will my personal tablet be completely reset in order to use with the 1:1 program? Yes. The Securly installation will completely erase everything on the iPad, and it will be enrolled in Apple Device Enrollment Program and will be managed by Securly until you notify us that you desire otherwise, at which point the device can no longer be brought to school.

We recommend that you backup your personal settings and data before we install Securly. Once Securly is installed, you will not be able to install apps without permission from the school as long as the tablet is part of the 1:1 program. Regardless of personal apps already installed, students are not to use any app at school unless allowed by a teacher.

I would like to participate in the lease-to-own program, but my child is in the 7th or 8th grade. If a student leaves LVAES before the completion of 30 payments toward the lease, he/she may purchase the iPad and case for \$460 minus any payments already made.

I am leasing-to-own an iPad. What happens if I damage it? Unless you have purchased insurance on the iPad, it is your responsibility to repair the iPad to like new condition at your own cost. Scratches will be charged at \$10 per scratch regardless of insurance coverage.

What insurance does LVAES offer for the lease-to-own iPads? Families may purchase insurance for lease-to-own iPads for \$35 a year, which covers accidental damage such as a broken screen, drop damage, and liquid damage. If damage occurs, a \$49 deductible will apply. This insurance will cover one damage per year. This insurance does not cover stolen or lost devices.
