

24 #2 pencils*

Eraser

Individual pencil sharpener

Wide-ruled notebook paper

2 Pocket Folders

1 - 1" binder (please no big binders)

2 Compositions books (not spiral notebooks)

2 black, blue, or colored pens

2 dry erase markers + sock or piece of cloth for erasing

Dry erase white board

clipboard (low-profile please)

2 - 3"x3" post-it note pads

12" ruler

Scissors

1 Elmer's School Glue

4 Elmer's Glue Stick

Markers

Color Pencils

Crayons (optional)

1 box of Kleenex
