Announcements

Attendance - The return to school following Christmas break has been a challenge considering the surge of the Omicron variant, exposures in our classrooms, and fear of the virus. This has led to a high rate of absenteeism, which is a strain on learning. We must push for a return to regular in-person attendance, while still following the VCPH protocol for dealing with COVID. Please keep your child at home if he/she is sick or required to quarantine, but please ensure that your child is in the classroom otherwise.

COVID Tests - LVAES is distributing an at-home COVID test kit to every student to be used in the event of an exposure or symptoms. Have you picked up yours yet?

MAP Testing is next week. Please ensure that your child attends school each day, gets good rest, and has a healthy breakfast.

Dress Code - Would you please help us by checking that your child is wearing the school uniform each morning? Logoed polo shirts (or equivalent dress) are required every day except Friday. Pants should be navy or khaki and should match what is seen on the Land's End website. Skirts/dresses should be near the knee. Jackets and sweatshirts should not have non-LVAES graphics or logos on them and should be navy, white, black, red, or blue. No bracelets, earrings, necklaces, or other accessories should be worn.

Ski Trip - Our ski trip will be on February 10. This is a school-coordinated family trip, and attendance is

encouraged but not required. LVAES teachers will be present but will not be transporting students to the resort, giving lessons, or supervising children on the slopes. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that your child has proper instruction and supervision. LVAES Handbook guidelines for conduct still apply. Please plan on arriving at the resort at 8:30. Teachers will be distributing tickets and rental vouchers at that time. The resort address is 24510 CA-2, Wrightwood, CA 92397. Driving time from Oxnard is approximately two hours and thirty minutes. LVAES loans out snow clothes to our students for free on a first-come, first-served basis. A \$20 cash deposit is required, and will be refunded when the clothes are returned washed and folded.
