Jog-a-thon - Our 4th Annual Roy Brasher Memorial Jog-a-thon is taking place in only two weeks! We sincerely ask that each of our students seeks sponsors to help us raise money in this event. Fall Fair - Our fall fair will take place from 11:00-2:00 on Sunday, November 3, following the jog-a-thon. This is one of our favorite annual events and helps to raise significant funds for campus improvements. This year's funds will be set aside for remodeling our office. To make the fall fair successful, we need lots of parent support. Here are a few things we'll need help with:

- Loaning us pop-up tents and extension cords
- Helping to set up tables and pop-up tents and running extension cords after sunset on Saturday evening, November 2.
- Taking turns to run class and club booths. We'll send sign ups soon for K-4 parents, and we'll create a schedule for 5th-8th graders that assigns times for class, NJHS, and Robotics booths.

Leo Carrillo Beach Day is next Friday, October 25! This will be for all students TK-8th, and we ask that all students attend, as this is a scheduled school day and is an intentional part of our whole-child program. This is not considered an optional school day. If you're concerned about the cold, please help your child pack a warm sweatshirt. Although students will be allowed to do sand play and wading, swimming and swim suits will not be allowed. Parents are invited to attend, but please remember that you must have a



background check and driver clearance to drive other people’s children. We will leave LVAES at 8:30 and will depart Leo Carrillo at 11:45, arriving back at LVAES at 12:30. Please return the attached permission slip on Monday! The cost of this trip is \$3 to cover parking, and drivers will receive a \$3 account credit per student that they drive. We’ll send out travel and parking directions closer to the day of the field trip.

Drop Off and Pick Up - A quick reminder that we invite parents/guardians to join us for the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer in the morning. Now that we have settled into the routine, we ask that you say goodbye to your student after prayer and allow them to walk to their classrooms with their teachers.

Please do not linger or enter the classrooms, as it can make it difficult for children to transition into school-mode, especially the younger students. We also ask that parents/guardians wait for dismissal by the picnic tables, and not by the classroom doors. Thank you for your help in creating smoother transitions.
