**Ski Clothes** - Snow clothes are available in the lunch room from 3:15-3:45 until Wednesday. Although class will not be in-person, this is considered a regular school day and students will be required to complete the work assigned. **Ski Trip Supervision** - Please note that families are required to arrange their own transportation to Mt. High and supervision for their child at the resort. Our staff cannot supervise students at the resort or instruct on the slopes.

## **Mt. High Ski Trip Info**

**What If My Child Does Not Attend the Mt. High Excursion?** - We have chosen to do this Mt. High trip for many years as part of our educational program because we believe it is important for our kids to try new things and challenge themselves in the beauty of God's creation. If your child does not attend, we encourage you to use this time to help your child grow in a creative way. We will not be assigning mandatory work on Thursday, February 6.

**Liability Waivers and Lesson Sign Ups** - If you are renting equipment, please be sure to sign the liability waiver and submit a hard copy to our office.

**Ski Clothes** - We make ski clothes available so you don't have to purchase new items for a one-time trip to the snow. These have been set up in the lunch room, and Ms. Lilly will be available daily from about 3:00 until about 3:45 to help you get what you need. We ask for a \$20 cash deposit per person, which will be returned to you once the items are returned laundered and in good condition. Please help us keep this program available for families in future years!

**Transportation and Supervision** - Please remember that parents must arrange transportation to, and supervision at, Mt. High. Our staff does not supervise or provide any lessons for students at Mt. High, and we cannot assume liability.

**Conduct** - Students represent our school wherever they go. Please help your child remember appropriate and respectful conduct while at Mt. High and leave the staff there with nothing but positive things to say about our students.

**Arrival Time** - Lesson groups begin forming at 9:45 and start promptly at 10:00. Please aim to arrive no later than 8:30 to allow plenty of time to get checked in and to get your rental equipment before lessons begin. Unfortunately, the process of getting our rental forms, rentals, and lift tickets is always a time-consuming and complicated process, no matter what we do on our end.

**Mt. High Address and Drive Time** - 24510 CA-2, Wrightwood, CA 92397. The distance from Oxnard is approximately two hours.

**Snow Chains** - We won't know if chains will be required until the middle of next week, but it's a good idea to have some in your vehicle just in case. Amazon usually sells them for a reasonable cost and will accept returns if they are unused.

**Parking** - Free parking is available at the bottom of the hill when you first pull into the resort area but requires a walk up to the lodge. Parking close to the resort is pricier than it should be!

**When You Arrive** - Proceed up the hill from the main lodge to the "Bullwheel" area, where we'll distribute your rental paperwork and lift tickets as we receive them from the Mt. High staff. Lessons will also meet at this area.
