iPads - Students will need their fully-charged iPads on the first day of school. If you are a new student or will be re-enrolling your BYOD iPad, we will install the software during the first week of school. Please be sure you have backed up any photos, have removed the lock screen passcode, and have signed out of iCloud.

on Tuesday, August 16, at 5:30 for an orientation. Returning families are welcome to join also.

Back to School Night - Join us on Tuesday, August 16, from 6:00-7:00 for Back to School night. Meet your child's teacher, learn important classroom information, and receive this year's wall calendar.
