MAP Testing Next Week - Every year we perform standardized testing in the fall, winter, and spring. These tests are not "high stakes" but give us the ability to assess student growth. Students take one test per morning. First and second grades will be done by Tuesday, and 3rd-8th grades will test Monday-Thursday. Please help your child get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast!

iPads Coming Soon - Mrs. Pennock has been working daily getting iPads set up and ready for student use. Students in 1st-8th will be using their iPads for their upcoming MAP testing. If you had not turned in your iPad to be set up for our school apps and security management please be sure turn it in to Mrs. Pennock as soon as possible

Pick Up From After School Activities - If your child is participating in sports, robotics, Crazy 8s, drama, praise band, or any other after-school activities students are expected to be picked up at the conclusion of the event. While we allow a 30 minute grace period at the end of the school day, we don't do this for extra curricular/after school activities. We will give families a 5 minute grace period. If students are not picked up by then, students will be signed into daycare and charges will apply. Parents will need to sign their child out of daycare. We want to make sure all our students are safe and supervised.

Chicken Club is starting this next week. We will be having an orientation meeting on Tuesday, September 17th during lunch. Any student in 3rd-8th grade can bring their lunch to Mrs. Pennock's room and learn more about chicken club. Students will have the opportunity to sign up to be a part of the club to help care for chickens and take farm fresh eggs home. The cost is \$7 a month and helps cover the cost of food for our flock.

Drama Club & Praise Band - Drama and Praise Band will be happening on alternating Thursdays from 3:30-4:15! Drama will be starting next Thursday, September 18 with games and activities to learn about what drama is. Space is limited. Those interested should sign up with Ms. Gram.
