Ski Trip Supervision - Please note that families are required to arrange their own transportation to Mt. High and supervision for their child at the resort. Students in K-4 must be accompanied by an adult family member. Students in 5-8 may attend without a parent, but must be under the supervision of an adult. Parents must make these arrangements.
