Pick Up From After School Activities - If your child is participating in sports, robotics, Crazy 8s, drama, praise band, or any other after-school activities students are expected to be picked up at the conclusion of the event.

While we allow a 30 minute grace period at the end of the school day, we don't do this for extra curricular/after school activities. We will give families a 5 minute grace period. If students are not picked up by then, students will be signed into daycare and charges will apply. Parents will need to sign their child out of daycare. We want to make sure all our students are safe and supervised.

Sports Participation - Playing team sports is a great opportunity to learn teamwork, sportsmanship, and balance.

When students, who are participating in sports have a game, they often leave early from school and miss class and/or assignments. Sports is an optional extracurricular activity and students are expected to be proactive in finding out what assignments they missed or will be missing. Teachers are not expected to excuse students from work when they participate in extracurricular activities, nor do teachers need to accommodate quiz and test schedules around games. Balancing any after school activities with in-school assignments and responsibilities help students learn skills that will help them in high school and in life.
