After School Pick Up. It is great that so many students love to be at school and beg their parents to let them stay longer and play with their friends. As a reminder, if you want to allow your child to play after you have come to pick them up, they must be in your direct supervision. Students not in the direct supervision of their parents will be charged for daycare. This includes when a parent is sitting in the car and letting their child hang out or play with their friends. I also ask that if you are able to pick up your child after school, and you don't need to have your child in daycare, that you pick them up after school. Please do not use daycare as a play date.

While we strive to keep our cost down while also providing a quality program at LVAES, we are needing to raise tuition this coming school year by 5%. This increase will allow us to keep our current staffing as well as meet the rising costs we face.
