Museum Night Details. Museum night is from 6:00-7:30 on Thursday evening, October 9!

Monday is the day to set up student's backdrops. The assigned rooms will be available from 7:45 - 9:00 a.m., as well as after school, starting at 3:30.

Tuesday morning will be a full dress-rehearsal, so please help your child memorize his/her speech before then, and bring them to school in their costumes. They will be changing to school uniforms immediately after the dress rehearsal, so *make sure you also send their appropriate uniforms!*

On **Thursday**, please have your student ready to go and at their designated galleries **no later than 5:45 p.m.** so we can start promptly at 6:00.

Museum Night procedure: Parents are asked to remain outside while the gallery docents get students settled and say a quick prayer. Students are expected to stay at their exhibits for the duration of the evening and will have short breaks between sessions to take care of any needs. Please remember that sound travels all too well in our hallways, and keep the outside conversations low to reduce the distraction and noise for our young exhibitors. We also ask that parents and guests do not enter the galleries if the doors are shut and students have already started their sets, as it could break their concentration or disrupt their speech.

Jog-a-thon - We had our Jog-a-thon kickoff today at chapel and details will be coming home with your students. Our 4th Annual Roy Brasher Memorial Jog-a-thon will take place on Sunday, November 2, followed by our Fall Fair.
