Teacher Inservice - Teachers will travel to Glendale next Wednesday afternoon for training, and school will dismiss at 11:30. Extended supervision will be available for charge from 12:00-3:30.

Enrollment '25-'26 - We are currently evaluating the first round of applications for 2025-2026 and are now accepting applications for the second round, which will be evaluated at the beginning of February. We have a few spots open in each grade level from K-6. The 7th/8th classroom is waitlisted, and the kindergarten class is already more than 50% full. Ski Trip - Our annual ski trip will take place on Thursday, February 6. This is an optional whole-school field trip to Mt. High ski resort in the San Gabriel Mountains. Although students are not required to attend, we strongly encourage everyone's participation. Families are welcome to attend. Prices and a sign up link can be found at lvaes.org/ski. Our goal is to have all sign ups completed by Tuesday, January 14.

Ski Trip Supervision - Please note that families are required to arrange their own transportation to Mt. High and supervision for their child at the resort. Our staff cannot supervise students at the resort or instruct on the slopes.

Ski Clothes - Snow clothes will be available in the lunch room from 3:15-3:45, January 27-February 5. A \$20 per person deposit will be required, which is fully refundable if the clothes are brought back, laundered, and in good repair. Please be sure to check with Ms. Lilly before looking through the clothes to help us maintain an orderly system! :)

Ski Trip Scholarships - If your child would like to learn to ski or snowboard but the cost is beyond your family's financial ability, please contact Mr. Fox regarding possible scholarships.

Artisan Club - We are partnering with Ventura County Handweavers and Spinners Guild to learn how to turn our raw wool into handicrafts. Students will card, spin, and dye (using natural and homemade dyes) our wool to make their own yarn, which will then be used to create weavings (or kept for their own knitting/crocheting projects). Since this is our first experience with this process, we will be working with a select group of 3rd-8th graders. We are still determining the schedule, but we expect this to begin in January and to take place on Thursdays after school.
